Mr. Speaker,

The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 379**, BOARD OF PARDONS AMENDMENTS, by Representative P. Ray, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 13 through 14:
 - 13 exempts the deliberative process { and day-to-day operations } of the Board of Pardons
 - 14 and Parole from Open and Public Meetings Act requirements; and
- 2. Page 2, Lines 43 through 46:
 - 43 (7) (a) "Deliberative process" means the board or any number of the board's individual
 - 44 members together engaging in discussions, whether written or verbal, regarding a parole, a
 - 45 <u>pardon, a commutation, termination of sentence, or restitution in an</u> <u>fines, fees, or restitution in an</u>
 - 46 individual case.
- 3. Page 6, Lines 164 through 166:
 - 164 {<u>-(8) Discussions of the Board of Pardons and Parole or the board's</u>
 members that pertain
 - 165 <u>only to day-to-day management and operation of the board are not a meeting as</u> <u>defined in</u>
 - 166 Section 52-4-103.
