Representative Raymond P. Ward proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 14 through 17:
 - directs the Department of Health to apply for a waiver from the federal government
 - 15 to {provide Medicaid coverage to a postpartum individual whose household income
 - 16 is at or below 200% of the federal poverty level continue Medicaid coverage for a Medicaid enrollee for a period of one year after the
 - 17 individual's pregnancy ends.
- 2. *Page 2, Lines 30 through 32:*
 - 30 (a) "Qualified postpartum individual" means a postpartum individual who { has a
 - 31 household income that is at or below 200% of the federal poverty level as defined in Section
 - 32 26-18-411.} was a Medicaid enrollee at the time of childbirth.
- 3. Page 2, Lines 38 through 40:
 - 38 (2) Before August 1, 2021, the division shall apply for a Medicaid waiver or a state
 - 39 <u>plan amendment with CMS to provide</u> <u>continuous</u> <u>Medicaid coverage to a qualified postpartum</u> {-woman} individual
 - 40 during the postpartum period.
