  - 41 armed forces, including embarrassment, { fear, and shame and the challenge of separating
  - 42 professional and personal duties; \ stigma, and fear of retaliation;
- 3. *Page 2, Lines 45 through 52:* 
  - 45 \{\frac{\text{WHEREAS}}{\text{according to the DOD report, individuals who experience sexual assault}}
  - 46 do not report their assault because they fear retaliation and the lack of confidentially when
  - 47 reported within the chain of command;
