Mr. Speaker,

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 197**, HIGHER EDUCATION FINANCIAL AID AMENDMENTS, by Representative T. Clancy, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 5, Lines 128 through 130:
 - 128 (4) A student is eligible for a promise grant until the student:
 - (a) earns a first bachelor's degree { or technical college certificate } ; or
 - (b) completes 120 credit hours.
- 2. Page 8, Lines 231 through 236:

 - 232 following occurs | {-when-} :
 - 233 (a) the qualifying military veteran completes the requirements for a bachelor's degree;
 - 234 or
 - (b) [12 months from the time that] the qualifying military veteran receives [an initial
 - 236 program grant] the maximum award that the board sets.
