Representative Mike Schultz proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 11 through 13:
  - 11 This bill:
  - disallows referral of a referendum to voters for { a land use law } municipal land use laws that passed by a
  - 13 {two-thirds} <u>unanimous</u> vote of the local legislative body.
- 2. Page 2, Lines 43 through 46:
  - 43 (b) In addition to the limitations of Subsection (2)(a), a proposed referendum is not
  - 44 legally referable to voters for a :
    - (i) municipal land use law, as defined in Section 20A-7-101, if the land use law was passed by a unanimous vote of the local legislative body; or
      - (ii)  $\{\frac{a}{a}\}$  transit area
  - 45 land use law, as defined in Section 20A-7-601, if the { land use law or } transit area land use law
  - was passed by a two-thirds vote of the local legislative body.
