Mr. Speaker,

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 29**, SENSITIVE MATERIAL REVIEW AMENDMENTS, by Representative K. Ivory, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 8 through 10:
  - 8 { Committee Note:
  - 9 The Education Interim Committee recommended this bill.
  - 10 <u>Legislative Vote: 10 voting for 4 voting against 6 absent</u> }
- 2. Page 3, Lines 76 through 80:
  - 76 (ii) "Sensitive material" does not include an instructional material:
  - 77 (A) that an LEA selects under Section 53G-10-402;

(B) for a concurrent enrollment course that contains sensitive material and for which a parent receives notice from the course provider of the material before enrolling and gives the parent's consent by enrolling;

- 78  $\{-(B)-\}$  (C) for medical courses;
- 79  $\{-(C)\}$  (D) for family and consumer science courses; or
- 80  $\{-(D)-\}$  <u>(E)</u> for another course the state board exempts in state board rule.
- 3. Page 5, Lines 132 through 133:
  - 132 (c) only if the LEA makes a determination that the challenged instructional material
    133 does not constitute objective sensitive material {review} :
- 4. Page 5, Lines 141 through 144:
  - 141 (iii) if the LEA makes a determination that the challenged instructional material
  - 142 <u>constitutes</u> {<u>objective</u>} <u>subjective</u> <u>sensitive material</u>, <u>ensure that the material</u>

is inaccessible to students in

- 143 <u>any school setting, including the termination of the parent consent option described in</u>
- 144 <u>Subsection (4)(c)(ii); and</u>
