Mr. President,

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 389**, MEDICAL CANNABIS PHARMACY MODIFICATIONS, by Representative W. Brooks, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 16, Lines 460 through 463:
 - region to open a closed-door medical cannabis pharmacy in the region;
 - 461 (c) { if } of the total amount of closed-door medical cannabis pharmacies, may allow only
 - 462 <u>three closed-door medical cannabis pharmacies to operate in counties of the first and second</u>
 - class as described in Section 17-50-501; and
- 2. Page 16, Lines 482 through 483:
 - 482 (ii) \$2,000,000 in total revenue.
 - (9) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, the department may issue only three closed-door medical cannabis pharmacy licenses before July 1, 2027.
 - 483 { (9) In accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah
 Administrative Rulemaking Act, the
