The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 389**, MEDICAL CANNABIS PHARMACY MODIFICATIONS, by Representative W. Brooks, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 16, Lines 460 through 463:*

460 region to open a closed-door medical cannabis pharmacy in the region;
