The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 92**, STUDENT COMMUNICATION METHODS, by Senator S. Pitcher, with the following amendments:

1. Page 7, Lines 197 through 203:

197	(22) <u>(a)</u>	A local school board shall { develop polices } approve an
	<b>LEA's policies</b>	and procedures that an LEA develops to ensure that students
198	have non-electron	tic notification of and access to:
199	{ <u> (a)</u> }	<u>(i)</u> school activities and events, including:
200	{ <del>_(i)_</del> }	(A) course work;
201	{ <u>_(ii)</u> _}	(B) schedule changes; and
202	{ <u>_(iii)</u> _}	(C) extracurricular activities; and
203	{ <del>_(b)_</del> }	the emergency response plans described in Subsections (20)
	and (21).	

- (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (22)(a), an LEA may provide electronic notification of and access to school activities and events as described in Subsections (22)(a)(i) and (ii) if:
  - (i) the school provides each student with an electronic device; and
- <u>(ii) the electronic device is capable of receiving electronic notification of and access to school activities and events as described in Subsections (22)(a)(i) and (ii).</u>
