Mr. Speaker,

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. S.B. 166**, HEALTH BENEFIT AMENDMENTS, by Senator M. S. Kennedy, with the following amendments, and, due to fiscal impact, recommends it be referred to the Rules Committee for prioritization.

- 1. Page 3, Lines 81 through 82:
  - qualified child was not enrolled in the eligible health benefit plan.

    (7) If a qualified child has the option to enroll in one of several eligible health benefit plans, the department shall, to the extent that is practicable, ensure that the number of qualified children receiving assistance under this section are divided evenly among eligible health benefit plans.
