1. H.B. HB0064 Property Tax Relief Amendments (*Peterson, J.*)

Rep. Peterson explained the bill.

Ms. Rebecca Rockwell, Commissioner, Utah State Tax Commission, spoke to the bill.

MOTION: Rep. Froerer moved to pass H.B. 64 out favorably. The motion passed with a vote of 7-0-5.
