**1. 2nd Sub. S.B. 50 Automobile Insurance Registry Amendments (*Fillmore, L.*)**

1. *Page 1, Lines 11 through 13:*

2. *Page 2, Lines 46 through 54:*

46 (2) (a) Subject to the restriction in Subsection (2)(b), the division or any peace  
officer,  
47 without a warrant, { }- **shall** { }- ~~may~~ seize and take possession of any  
vehicle that is being operated  
48 on a highway without owner's or operator's security in effect for the vehicle as required  
under  
49 Section 41-12a-301 { }- **unless the division or any peace officer makes a**  
**reasonable determination**

51 ~~—+ }~~ **(i) the seizure of the vehicle would present a public safety concern to the**  
**operator or**
