 - 220 <u>student's online behavior, or usage of applications</u>.
 - 221 <u>(b) "Targeted advertising" does not include advertisements presented to a</u> student on an
 - 222 <u>internal or external application:</u>
 - 223 <u>(i) where the advertisement is selected based upon the student's current visit to</u> <u>or</u>

- 224 <u>single search query on a site, software, service, or application; or</u>
- 225 <u>(ii) for a nonprofit institution of higher education or scholarship provider.</u>}
- 226 (25) (a) "Targeted advertising" means presenting advertisements to a

student where the advertisement is selected based on information obtained or inferred over time from that student's online behavior, usage of applications, or student data.

(b) "Targeted advertising" does not include advertising to a student: (i) at an online location based upon that student's current visit to that location; or

<u>(ii) in response to that student's request for information or feedback, without</u> retention of that student's online activities or requests over time for the purpose of targeting subsequent ads.
