
PROCLAMATION


WHEREAS, the undersigned has since been informed of the need to include an additional item of business for consideration in this Fifth Special Session;



3. To consider delaying the effective date of the 2006 General Session Senate Bill 161, Mechanic's Lien and Payment Amendments.
