Office of the Legislative Auditor General

The major function of this office is to conduct performance audits of state departments, institutions, school districts, special districts, and state colleges and universities. Performance audits help legislators resolve difficult issues. The audits conducted by the Office of the Legislative Auditor General examine the operations of state programs in a variety of areas. The office reviews and evaluates the implementation, administration, and cost–effectiveness of the programs.

A performance audit can serve one or more functions. The audit may show an agency or program is more expensive than it needs to be (i.e., is it operating efficiently?). It may indicate places where an agency or program is not fulfilling its mission and serving the public (i.e., is it effective?). An audit may also point out problems with interpreting the legislature's intent when it created an agency or program (i.e., is it complying with the law?). All this information is given to legislators in performance terms, along with recommendations for actions that need to be taken.

To request an audit, a legislator submits a written request to the auditor general. Also requests from legislative committees, subcommittees, and task forces can be submitted. Other audit assignments are developed as a result of committee study assignments, allegations from the public, and concerns identified as a result of previous audits. All audit assignments are reviewed and approved by the Audit Subcommittee of the Legislative Management Committee.

Each member of the legislature receives a summary report of all audit findings, and a complete report is sent to members of the appropriate committees. Extra copies of all reports are available upon request to any member of the legislature and the general public.

Office of the Legislative Fiscal Analyst

The Legislative Fiscal Analyst advises all Utah state legislators on matters of public finance.

Prior to each legislative session, the Fiscal Analyst prepares detailed revenue estimates for the state's operating funds. These estimates are considered in conjunction with estimates prepared by the executive branch and crafted into consensus revenue estimates for both the Governor and Legislature. They are again considered and updated near the end of each General Session.

Thirty-four days in advance of each General Session, the governor is required to deliver proposed budget recommendations to the Office of the Legislative Fiscal Analyst on a confidential basis. The Fiscal Analyst reviews the executive budget before the legislature convenes and makes recommendations and comments to the legislature on each item or program. These recommendations and comments include not only specific funding levels but also: (1) instances in which the administration may be failing to carry out the expressed intent of the legislature; (2) proposed new services contained in the governor's budget; and (3) each item which has been previously denied by the legislature.

Just prior to and during each session, the Fiscal Analyst gathers and analyzes data and prepares and presents reports to the nine appropriations subcommittees. Members of the Fiscal Analyst's office staff the subcommittees of the Joint Appropriations Committee and are responsible for presenting independent recommendations to the subcommittees.

The Fiscal Analyst and staff also respond to information requests of the Executive Appropriations Committee and under its direction prepare appropriations bills for consideration of the legislature.

The Fiscal Analyst and staff also prepare fiscal notes for proposed legislation. Since most bills have some cost or fiscal implication, the Fiscal Analyst's task identifies that cost or implication by analysis which may include contact with agencies affected by the legislation. Fiscal notes represent an independent cost and review appraisal of a bill.

Following each legislative session, the Fiscal Analyst prepares and issues a report on the fiscal impact of legislative action taken. This report is issued under the title "Appropriations Report" and contains a summary of all appropriations, denials, reductions, and increases; revenue measures; new programs; and expressed legislative intent. During the interim, the Fiscal Analyst prepares studies and reports as assigned by the various legislative committees.

The Fiscal Analyst is also directed by law to "propose and analyze statutory changes to effect operational economies for more effective administration" and "to conduct organizational and management improvement studies."

Legislative Printing Office

The Legislative Printing Office was established in 1975 and placed under the direction of the legislative fiscal analyst. The office provides printing, typesetting, and graphic service to the legislature, its staff offices, and other state agencies. During the legislative session, the major responsibilities of the printing office include preparation of the daily House and Senate Journals, House and Senate bills, amendments, agendas, minutes, status sheets, and miscellaneous printing. In the interim, the office publishes the final House and Senate Journals, *Laws of Utah*, reports, manuals, management audits, and other state agency publications.

During the 1985 legislative session, the Legislative Printing office was assigned responsibility for the distribution of all legislative publications, including the Utah Code, Utah Code Annotated, Laws of Utah, House and Senate Journals, and general extracts of law.

In 1994, the Legislative Printing Office took over the operations of the Legislative Bill Room. In 1995, the Bill Room and Legislative Printing Office combined offices. Office of Legislative Research and General Counsel

The Office of Legislative Research and General Counsel provides research and legal services to the legislature, including legal and policy review of current law and proposed legislation and all legal support services for the legislature, including representing the legislature in litigation. The office promotes an understanding of critical legislative issues, serves as a liaison with other government agencies and the public, and is responsible for recommending changes in the law and drafting legislation.

An analyst and an attorney contribute subject area expertise to standing and interim committees and facilitate the coordination of legal and research functions for each committee. They assist the committees in planning and preparing research studies and organizing and scheduling meetings; accumulate and analyze data relating to the practical operation of previously enacted statutes; collect and examine acts and official reports from other states; compile analytical, statistical, legal, and descriptive data pertaining to legislative and governmental issues; provide legal background information on issues; respond to individual requests for information; and draft legislation as assigned.

The office reviews all proposed legislation before introduction in a session and prepares requested amendments and substitute bills or resolutions after the

legislation has been introduced. Before bills passed by the legislature are submitted to the governor, the office reviews each bill to assure it meets the constitutional standards for final passage and makes technical corrections through the enrolling process. The office prepares the chapterization of the bills which are adopted in each session and provides the Legislative Printing Office with this update and the enrolled copies of all legislation. Following each session, document technicians update the statutory database of the *Utah Code* for statutory searches and bill drafting purposes.

The office maintains a legislative information center that is available to legislators, their committees, legislative staff, and the public. The direct line to the information center is (801) 326–1600.


