- 19 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
- 20 Section 1. Section **53-5a-105** is enacted to read:
- 21 <u>53-5a-105</u>. Possession of an altered toy, look-alike, or imitation firearm by a
- 22 minor.
- 23 (1) As used in this section:
- 24 (a) "Altered toy, look-alike, or imitation firearm" means a toy, look-alike, or imitation
- 25 <u>firearm that has been altered so that a reasonable person would believe that the toy,</u>
- look-alike, or imitation firearm is an actual firearm.
- 27 (b) "Minor" means an individual younger than 18 years old.
