1. *Line 604 through 607:*

- 604 (b) two individuals appointed by the governor;
605 (c) one individual appointed by the president of the Senate; {and}
606 (d) one individual appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives {;} ;
 (e) one non-voting member appointed by the minority leader in the Senate; and
 (f) one non-voting member appointed by the minority leader in the House of

- 672 (9) identify and recommend solutions to barriers affecting electrical energy development;
 (10) assess and address potential public health impacts of electrical energy development

674 {(11)} (12) report annually by October 31 to the Public Utilities, Energy, and Technology
