- 2. *Line 39 through 44:*
 - 39 high-cost health care needs who purchase rebate-paying drugs needs to end;
 - WHEREAS, this financial burden amounts to about {2.8} two million dollars in costs for those
 - 41 members that purchase rebate-paying drugs;
 - WHEREAS, if that financial burden were to be spread across the total membership of
 - the state risk pool, the cost would equal about {\$3.81} \$2.84 per member per month; and
 - WHEREAS, this change will provide relief to state employees and their family members

 - members by increasing the member premium share or reducing the state's health savings
 - 54 <u>account contribution.</u>
