1. *Line 233 through 235:*

233 (5) "Code red event" means a weather event in which the National Weather Service predicts

2. *Line 295 through 297:*

295 county for the duration of a code red alert:

3. *Line 326 through 328:*

326 (1)(a) through (f) to take effect, including local zoning ordinances.
327 (2) A homeless shelter owned by a municipality may expand the homeless shelter's capacity
 limit to provide temporary shelter to any number of individuals experiencing homelessness, so
 long as the homeless shelter is in compliance with the applicable building code and fire code.
