Representative **Andrew Stoddard** proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Line 13 through 15:
  - →requires that a governor's selection for chief justice is subject to the advice and consent of
  - the Senate; {-and}
    - → provides that the justices of the Supreme Court shall elect the president of the Senate and the speaker of the House of Representatives; and
  - 15 →makes conforming changes.
- 2. *Line 26 through 28:* 
  - 26 **78A-3-101** Number of justices -- Terms -- Appointment by governor with advice
  - and consent of Senate -- Chief justice and associate chief justice -- Selection and functions <u>--</u> Election of president of the Senate and speaker of the House of Representatives.
  - 28 (1) The Supreme Court consists of five justices.
- 3. Line 71:
  - served as associate chief justice.
    - (7) Following a general election and before January 1 of odd-numbered years, the justices of the Supreme Court shall elect:
    - (a) a president from among the members of the Senate as the Senate will be constituted based on the results of the general election; and
    - (b) a speaker from among the members of the House of Representatives as the House of Representatives will be constituted based on the results of the general election.
