

Senator **Karen Kwan** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Line 215 through 221:*

215 uses that access to influence legislative decisions.

216 {(a) **Appropriate attire on the Senate floor is:**}

217 {(i) **for men, a suit or jacket with a tie; and**}

218 {(ii) **for women, business professional attire.**}

219 {(b) **Hats are prohibited on the Senate floor or in the Senate gallery unless the hat is part**
220 **of a uniform or religious attire.**}

(a) **Except as provided in Subsection (2)(b):**

(i) **business professional attire is required on the Senate floor, similar to the following:**

(A) **a suit or jacket with a tie;**

(B) **a professional dress or skirt; or**

(C) **a dress shirt or blouse; and**

(ii) **hats are prohibited on the Senate floor and in the Senate gallery.**

(b) **Subsection (2)(a) does not prohibit an individual from wearing:**

(i) **a uniform; or**

(ii) **attire that is consistent with the individual's religious or cultural customs.**
