Senator **Karen Kwan** proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Line 215 through 221:
  - uses that access to influence legislative decisions.
  - 216 (2) {(a) Appropriate attire on the Senate floor is:}
  - 217 {(i) for men, a suit or jacket with a tie; and}
  - 218 {(ii) for women, business professional attire.}
  - 219 {(b) Hats are prohibited on the Senate floor or in the Senate gallery unless the hat is part
  - 220 of a uniform or religious attire.
    - (a) Except as provided in Subsection (2)(b):
    - (i) business professional attire is required on the Senate floor, similar to the following:
    - (A) a suit or jacket with a tie;
    - (B) a professional dress or skirt; or
    - (C) a dress shirt or blouse; and
    - (ii) hats are prohibited on the Senate floor and in the Senate gallery.
    - (b) Subsection (2)(a) does not prohibit an individual from wearing:
    - (i) a uniform; or
    - (ii) attire that is consistent with the individual's religious or cultural customs.
