28	individual's pregnancy, childbirth, and postpartum period.
29	(2)(a) Before October 1, 2025, the department shall apply for a Medicaid state plan
30	amendment to cover doula services.
31	(b) The department shall develop the state plan amendment in consultation with
32	individuals representing patients, doulas, physicians, nurses, and health care facilities
33	in the state.
34	(3) If the state plan amendment is approved, the Medicaid program shall provide coverage
35	of doula services.
36	(4) The department shall establish through rule made in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter
37	3, Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act, training and registration requirements for a
38	doula providing doula services to an enrollee.
39	Section 2. Effective date.
40	This bill takes effect on May 7, 2025.
