



## HB0324S01 compared with HB0324S02

- 15       ▶ provides that a vintage vehicle is not required to make the voluntary contribution to obtain  
16       the historical support special group license plate;  
17       ▶ amends the definition of a vintage vehicle to exclude the requirement regarding the type of  
18       license plate to be displayed; and  
19       ▶ makes technical changes.

- 21       ▶ This bill appropriates \$3,500,000 in expendable funds and accounts for fiscal year 2026, all  
22       of which is from the General Fund.

37       (1) In accordance with this chapter, the division shall issue to an eligible applicant a special group

47 (1) As used in this section, "fund" means the Sponsored Special Group License Plate Fund created in Subsection (2).
