## 21 <u>63G-6a-111.1.</u> Requirements for landscape maintenance.

- 22 (1) As used in this section:
- 23 (a) "Grounds" means the same as that term is defined in Section 63A-5b-1108.
- 24 (b) "Landscape maintenance" means mowing, edging, trimming, fertilizing, raking, or blowing leaves, lawn, flora, or organic material.
- 26 (c) "Landscape maintenance equipment" means any device primarily designed as a tool for the performance of landscape maintenance.
- 28 (d) "Lawn" means the same as lawn or turf is defined in Section 63A-5b-1108.
- 29 (e) "State government facility" means the same as that term is defined in Section 63A-5b-1108.
- 31 (2) Subject to Subsections (3) and (4):
- 32 (a) beginning July 1, 2025, a person performing landscape maintenance on a state government facility having less than 10,000 square feet of property needing landscape maintenance shall use handheld electric landscape maintenance equipment;
- 35 (b) beginning July 1, 2026, a person performing landscape maintenance on a state government facility having less than 30,000 square feet of property needing landscape maintenance shall use handheld electric landscape maintenance equipment;
- 38 (c) beginning July 1, 2027, a person performing landscape maintenance on a state government facility having less than 50,000 square feet of property needing landscape maintenance shall use handheld electric landscape maintenance equipment;
- 41 (3) The director of the Division of Facilities Construction and Management may grant an exemption from a requirement under Subsections (2)(a) through (c) if:
