19 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

20 Section 1. Section 1 is enacted to read:

21 **53E-3-525. State board transparency.**

23 (1) Beginning May 7, 2026, the state board shall:

24 {~~(a)~~ {publish the following information on the state board's website:}} }

25 ~~{(i)}~~ (a) publish on the state board's website a record of each vote by the state board, including:

26 ~~{(A)}~~ (i) the date, time, and place of the meeting;

27 ~~{(B)}~~ (ii) the subject of the vote;

28 ~~{(C)}~~ (iii) the names of state board members present and absent;

29 ~~{(D)}~~ (iv) the result of the vote, including each board member's individual vote;and

30 ~~{(E)}~~ (v) the audio or video associated with the vote; {and}

31 ~~{(F)~~ {meeting minutes, notes, and other records related to the vote in accordance with Title 52, Chapter
4, Open and Public Meetings Act;}} }

33 ~~{(ii)}~~ {a meeting agenda for a meeting scheduled to occur within the next 24 hours; and} }

34 ~~{(iii)}~~ {a contract the state board intends to consider at a meeting at least seven days before the date on
which the meeting is scheduled to occur;}} }

36 (b) distribute a contract the state board intends to consider at a meeting to each state board member at
least {seven} five days before the date on which the meeting is scheduled to occur;

39 (c) ensure the information described in Subsection (1)(a) is accessible through a single click from the
state board's home webpage;and

41 (d) post the information required by Subsection (1)(a) within 7 business days after a vote{;and};
