76-9-102.1, Utah Code Annotated 1953
Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
Section 1. Section <b>76-9-102.1</b> is enacted to read:
<u>76-9-102.1</u> . Aggravated disorderly conduct on a street or highway.
(1) Terms defined in Section 76-1-101.5 apply to this section.
(2) An actor commits aggravated disorderly conduct on a street or highway if the actor:
(a) intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly obstructs vehicular or pedestrian traffic on a
street or highway with:
(i) a speed limit of 40 miles per hour or more; or
(ii) at least two lanes in the same direction of travel; and
(b) refuses to comply with the lawful order of a law enforcement officer to move from
the street or highway.
(3)(a) Except as provided in Subsection (3)(b), a violation of Subsection (2) is a class A
misdemeanor.
(b) A violation of Subsection (2) is a third degree felony if within one year before the
day on which the actor violates this section, the actor was previously convicted of a
