Water Rights Restricted Account. 21 (1) As used in this section: 22 (a) "Account" means the Water Rights Restricted Account created by this section. 23 (b) "Division" means the Division of Water Rights. 24 (2) There is created in the General Fund a restricted account known as the "Water Rights 25 Restricted Account." (3) The account shall consist of the money deposited into the account under Subsection 26 27 59-12-103(5)(e). 28 (4) Upon appropriation, the division may use money in the account for: 29 (a) costs incurred by the division that benefit water rights adjudications, including: 30 (i) employing technical staff; 31 (ii) acquiring equipment;

19	This bill takes effect on May 7, 2025.
