5	This bill addresses public funding for transgender medical treatments and procedures.

8	 prohibits the use of public funds to pay or otherwise reimburse for the performance of
9	specified transgender medical treatments and procedures; and
10	 makes technical and conforming changes.

22	Section 1. Section 63G-29-101 is amended to read:
23	CHAPTER 29. LIMITATIONS ON GOVERNMENT
24	63G-29-101 . Definitions.
25	(1)(a) "Governmental entity" means:
26	(i) the state;
27	(ii) a county, city, town, school district, special district, special service district, or
28	other political subdivision of the state; or
29	(iii) an independent entity.
30	(b) "Governmental entity" includes an agency, bureau, office, department, division,

31	board, commission, institution, laboratory, or other instrumentality of an entity
32	described in Subsection (1)(a).
33	(2) "Independent entity" means the same as that term is defined in Section 63E-1-102.
34	(3) "Members of a person's social network" means the people a person authorizes to be part
35	of the person's social media communications and network.
36	(4) "Public funds" means the same as that term is defined in Section 51-7-3.
37	[(4)] (5)(a) "Social credit score" means a numeric, alphanumeric, or alphabetic value or
38	other categorization assigned to a person based on:
39	(i) the person's:
40	(A) compliance or noncompliance with government guidance;
41	(B) social media post;
42	(C) participation or membership in a lawful club, association, or union;
43	(D) political affiliation; or
44	(E) employment industry or employer; or
45	(ii) the identity of the members of the person's social network.
46	(b) "Social credit score" does not include:
47	(i) a consumer report as defined in 15 U.S.C. Sec. 1681a;
48	(ii) compliance or noncompliance with statute, administrative rule, or other law; or
49	(iii) a numeric, alphanumeric, or alphabetic value or other categorization assigned to
50	a person for:
51	(A) purposes of education, training, or job performance assessment;
52	(B) purposes of a contest or competition;
53	(C) purposes of hiring a prospective employee or independent contractor;
54	(D) purposes of issuance or taking an action against a professional license,
55	certification, registration, or permit;
56	(E) purposes of a professional or tax audit; or
57	(F) use by a financial institution or an affiliate of a financial institution regulated
58	under Title V of the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act, 15 U.S.C. Sec. 6801 et seq., to

62	63G-29-301 . Public funding for transgender procedures prohibited.
63	A governmental entity may not expend public funds to pay or otherwise reimburse,
64	either directly or indirectly, any person for the performance of:

- 65 (1) hormonal transgender treatment as defined in Section 58-1-603;
- 66 (2) a primary sex characteristic surgical procedure as defined in Section 58-67-102; or
- 67 (3) a secondary sex change characteristic surgical procedure as defined in Section 58-67-102.
- 68 Section 3. Effective Date.
- 69 This bill takes effect on May 7, 2025.
