Be it resolved by the Legislature of the state of Utah, two-thirds of all members elected to each of the two houses voting in favor thereof:

Section 1. It is proposed to enact Utah Constitution, Article XVI, Section 9, to read:

21 <u>Article XVI, Section 9</u>. [Right to work.]

22 <u>It is unlawful for any person, individual, corporation, or association, or this state or its</u>

23 political subdivisions, to deny employment to any individual by reason of the individual's

24 membership in, affiliation with, resignation from, or refusal to join or affiliate with any labor

25 <u>union or employee organization.</u>

Section 2. Submittal to voters.

27 The lieutenant governor is directed to submit this proposed amendment to the voters of

the state at the next regular general election in the manner provided by law.

29 Section 3. **Contingent effective date.**

If the amendment proposed by this joint resolution is approved by a majority of those
