	Section 1. Section 31A-22-662 is enacted to read:
	31A-22-662 . Immunization cost reimbursement.
<u>(1)</u>	As used in this section:
	(a) "Qualifying physician" means an individual:
	(i) licensed under Title 58, Chapter 67, Utah Medical Practice Act, or Title 58,
	Chapter 68, Utah Osteopathic Medical Practice Act; and
	(ii) that does not contract, personally or through another entity, with any health
	benefit plan to be a paneled provider for a health benefit plan.
	(b)(i) "Vaccine cost" means the cost of purchasing a vaccine from a pharmaceutical
	company.
	(ii) "Vaccine cost" does not include any fee or payment for the service of
	recommending, prescribing, or providing a vaccine to an individual.

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32	(2)(a) A health benefit plan shall reimburse a qualifying physician's vaccine cost
33	incurred by the qualifying physician for providing a covered vaccine to the health
34	benefit plan's enrollee.
35	(b) Except as provided in Subsection (2)(c), the reimbursement described in Subsection
36	(2)(a) shall be equal to the vaccine cost the health benefit plan would reimburse an
