4 General Description:

This bill addresses a program that offers a discounted annual pass to state parks for

6 qualified veterans.

- requires the Division of State Parks to offer the discounted veteran pass at a reduction of
- at least 25% of the price of a state parks annual day-use pass; and
- rulemaking authority to establish the program.

36	(1) The division shall make rules, in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah
37	Administrative Rulemaking Act, to grant free admission to state parks to an honorably
38	discharged veteran who:
39	(a) is a resident of the state; and
40	(b) has a current service-connected disability rating issued by the United States Veterans
41	Benefits Administration.
42	(2)(a) The division shall offer, as funding allows, a discounted annual day-use pass to
43	state parks to a veteran who:
44	(i) is a resident of this state; and
45	(ii) is generally or honorably discharged from military service.
46	(b) The division shall offer the discounted veteran pass described in Subsection (2)(a) at
47	a reduction of at least 25% of the price of a state parks annual day-use pass.
48	(c) The division may make rules to establish the program described in this Subsection (2).
49	[(2)(a) Beginning on July 1, 2024, and ending on June 30, 2025, the division shall offer a
50	pilot program that grants free admission to state parks to a veteran who:]
51	[(i) is a resident of the state; and]
52	[(ii) has an Interagency Military-Lifetime Pass for national parks and federal recreational
53	lands.]
54	[(b) The division may make rules to establish the pilot program described in Subsection
55	(2)(a).]
56	Section 3. FY 2025 Appropriation.
57	The following sums of money are appropriated for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
58	2024, and ending June 30, 2025. These are additions to amounts previously appropriated for
59	fiscal year 2025.

61	The Legislature authorizes the State Division of Finance to transfer the following

73	ITEM 2 To Department of Veterans and Military Affairs - DVMA Pass Through

77	The Legislature intends that the Department of	
78	Veterans and Military Affairs pass through the	
79	appropriation under this section to the Division of State	
80	Parks to pay for discounted veteran admission to state	
81	parks in accordance with Subsection 79-4-1002(2).
