53G-9-102, as enacted by Laws of Utah 2018, Chapter 3

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **53G-9-102** is amended to read:

53G-9-102 . Definitions.

[Reserved] As used in this chapter:

- (1) "Extraordinary costs" means costs that exceed standard educational expenses due to the need for specialized medical services and equipment.
- (2) "Medically fragile student" means a student who requires intensive medical care and has a condition that significantly impacts the student's ability to attend regular classes without specialized medical services.

Section 2. **Effective Date.**

This bill takes effect on May 7, 2025.
