LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill amends provisions related to the Public Employees' Benefit and Insurance Program.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- requires the Public Employees' Benefit and Insurance Program to allow a newly born or adopted child to be added to a health plan within 60 days of the birth or the adoption.

REPEALS:

34-49-101, as enacted by Laws of Utah 2015, Chapter 156

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **49-20-407.1** is enacted to read:

49-20-407.1 . Time to add child to plan

(1) After a birth or adoption, the program shall allow an individual to add the individual's newly born or adopted child to the individual's health plan or health coverage for a period of 60 days after the day the birth or adoption of the child occurred.

(2) The requirement described in Subsection (1) applies to an individual covered within the state risk pool.
