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18 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*19 Section 1. Section **63G-6b-301** is amended to read:20 **63G-6b-301 . Direct award grant requirements.**

21 (1)(a) A direct award grant is valid only if the direct award grant's grant appropriation:

22 (i) identifies the recipient or class of recipients in the grant appropriation's intent
23 language[-] ; and24 (ii) states in the grant appropriation's intent language the information described in
25 Subsections 63G-6b-201(4)(a) through (c).26 (b) For a grant appropriation that is an ongoing appropriation to fund a multi-year grant,
27 the [~~requirement to identify the recipient or class of recipients applies~~] requirements
28 described in Subsection (1)(a) apply each fiscal year.

29 (2) If the intent language for a direct award grant's grant appropriation provides a

30 disbursement schedule that is inconsistent with the schedule described in Section [

31 ~~63G-6b-202]~~ 63G-6b-201, for the fiscal year in which the grant appropriation is made,
32 the schedule in the intent language controls.

33 Section 2. **Effective Date.**
