63I-2-213, as last amended by Laws of Utah 2024, Third Special Session, Chapter 5

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **63I-2-213** is amended to read:

63I-2-213 . Repeal dates: Title 13.

- (1) Section 13-1-16, Latino Community Support Restricted Account, is repealed July 1, 2024.
- (2) Section 13-14-103, Utah Motor Vehicle Franchise Advisory Board -- Creation -- Appointment of members -- Alternate members -- Chair -- Quorum -- Conflict of interest, is repealed October 1, 2024.
- (3) Section 13-35-103, Utah Powersport Vehicle Franchise Advisory Board -- Creation -- Appointment of members -- Alternate members -- Chair -- Quorum -- Conflict of interest, is repealed October 1, 2024.
- (4) Title 13, Chapter 47, Private Employer Verification Act, is repealed on the program start date, as defined in Section 63G-12-102.
- (5) Title 13, Chapter 72, Artificial Intelligence Policy Act, is repealed [May] July 1, [2025]

32 Section 2. **Effective Date.**

33 This bill takes effect:

34 (1) except as provided in Subsection (2), May 7, 2025; or

35 (2) if approved by two-thirds of all members elected to each house:

36 (a) upon approval by the governor;

37 (b) without the governor's signature, the day following the constitutional time limit of
38 Utah Constitution, Article VII, Section 8; or

39 (c) in the case of a veto, the date of veto override.
