- 19 Be it resolved by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
- WHEREAS, Article V of the United States Constitution provides that "on the application of
- 21 the legislatures of two thirds of the several states, [Congress] shall call a convention for
- 22 proposing amendments...to this Constitution":
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the state of Utah hereby
- 24 makes an application to Congress, as provided by Article V of the Constitution of the United
- 25 States of America, to call a convention limited to proposing an amendment to the Constitution
- of the United States of America to set a limit on the number of terms that a person may be
- 27 elected as a member of the United States House of Representatives and to set a limit to the
- 28 number of terms that a person may be elected as a member of the United States Senate.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall be considered as covering the
- 30 same subject matter as the applications from other states to Congress to call a convention to set

a limit on the number of terms that a person may be elected as a member of the United States 32 House of Representatives and the United States Senate and shall be aggregated with the same 33 for the purpose of attaining the two-thirds of states necessary to require Congress to call a 34 limited convention on this subject, but shall not be aggregated with any other applications on 35 any other subject. 36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution constitutes a continuing application in 37 accordance with Article V of the United States Constitution until the legislatures of at least two-thirds of the several states have made applications on the same subject. 38 39 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to the Majority Leader 40 and Secretary of the United States Senate, the Speaker, Clerk, and Judiciary Chairman of the United States House of Representatives, the members of Utah's congressional delegation, and 42 the presiding officers of each of the legislative houses in the several states, requesting their 43 cooperation.
