The Transportation, Public Utilities, Energy, and Technology Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **2nd Sub. H.B. 70**, DECOMMISSIONED ASSET DISPOSITION AMENDMENTS, by Representative R. Neil Walter, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page Line 114 through 119:
 - least two years, beginning on July 2, 2025.
 - 115 {<u>(8)Prior to the disposal of a project entity asset, the project entity shall</u>

 provide a notice to }
 - 116 { the Legislative Management Committee that the project entity has satisfied all material }
 - 117 {<u>conditions, promises, and inducements made to any municipal or cooperative</u> project-}
 - 118 { <u>purchaser to obtain approval from the municipal or cooperative project</u> <u>purchaser for the </u>}
 - 119 { early decommissioning of a project entity asset. }
- 2. *Page Line 320 through 322:*
 - 320 (g)establish policies and procedures for the management of a decommissioned asset;
 - 321 (h) {oversee} administer contracts for the management and operations of a decommissioned asset;
