The Education Committee recommends **H.B. 100**, FOOD SECURITY AMENDMENTS, by Representative T. Clancy, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 100**, FOOD SECURITY AMENDMENTS with the following amendments:

- 1. Page Line 11 through 13:
 - 11 Benefits Transfer for Children Program;
 - 12 →provides {-all-} <u>certain</u> reduced-price eligible students access to school meals at no charge;
 - 13 →requires the State Board of Education to reimburse each local education agency (LEA) for
- 2. Page Line 70 through 72:
 - 70 for eating, and implement practices that help reduce food waste.
 - (b)"Eligible student" means a student
 <u>enrolled in kindergarten through grade</u>
 who qualifies for reduced-price meals based on
 - 72 household size and income levels under the School Breakfast Program or National
