Mr. Speaker,

The Revenue and Taxation Committee reports a favorable recommendation on 2nd Sub. H.B. 162, TRANSPORTATION FUNDING AMENDMENTS, by Representative R. P. Shipp, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page Line 9 through 12:
  - 9 for public safety purposes to:
  - 10  $\rightarrow$  allow funds to be used for infrastructure  $\{\frac{1}{2}, \frac{1}{2}, \frac{1}{2}\}$  and equipment; and
  - →prohibit the use of funds for salaries <u>, vehicles</u>, or operations and 11 maintenance; and
  - 12 →makes technical changes.
- Page Line 47 through 54: 2.
  - a county legislative body of a county of the third through sixth class: 47
  - 48 (i)may use the funds for  $\{\div\}$ \_public safety infrastructure, including jails or other buildings; and
  - 49 {<u>(A)public safety infrastructure, including jails or other buildings; or</u>}
  - { (B)public safety or law enforcement vehicles or equipment; and } 50
  - (ii)may not use the funds for: 51
  - (A)operations or maintenance of public safety entities; {-or} 52 public safety or law enforcement vehicles or equipment; or **(B)** 53
    - (C) salaries of public safety or law enforcement personnel. {<del>(B)</del>}
  - 54 (4) Notwithstanding Section 59-12-2208, the opinion question required by Section
