The Business, Labor, and Commerce Committee recommends **H.B. 186**, WAGE PAYMENT AMENDMENTS, by Representative K. J. Christofferson, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 186**, WAGE PAYMENT AMENDMENTS with the following amendments:

- 1. Page Line 41 through 45:
  - 41 (i) the unpaid wages of the employee become due immediately[7]; and
  - 42 (ii) the employer shall pay the wages to the employee within {24 hours} one business day of the time of
  - 43 separation at the specified place of payment.
  - 44 (b) An employer satisfies the {24-hour} one business day time requirement described in Subsection (1)(a) if:
  - 45 (i) (A) the employer mails the wages to the employee; and
- 2. Page Line 48 through 50:
  - 48 the employer's payroll; or
  - 49 (ii) within {24 hours} one business day after the employer separates the employee from the employer's
  - 50 payroll, the employer:
- 3. Page Line 52 through 54:
  - 52 (B) hand delivers the wages to the employee.
