Mr. Speaker,

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 204**, STIPENDS FOR FUTURE EDUCATORS GRANT PROGRAM AMENDMENTS, by Representative K. M. Peterson, with the following amendments:

1. Line 30 through 37:

- 30 (a) "Eligible student teacher" means a student teacher who:
- 31 (i) is enrolled in an educator preparation program that leads to a ~~{Utah}~~ professional
- 32 level educator license, regardless of whether the student teacher is enrolled at a
- 33 state institution described in Section 53B-1-102, or another public or private
- 34 institution within the state or another state; ~~{and}~~
- 35 (ii) works at an LEA within the state as a full-time student teacher to meet the educator
- 36 preparation program requirements ~~{-}~~ ; and
- 37 (iii) signs an affidavit demonstrating the student teacher's intent to work in Utah and pursue a Utah professional level educator license.
- 37 (b) "License" means the same as that term is defined in Section 53E-6-102.

2. Line 49 through 52:

- 49 (e) does not receive compensation during the student teaching experience from:
- 50 (i) an LEA, unless the eligible student teacher works as a substitute teacher or ~~{athletic~~
- 51 ~~coach}~~ in an extracurricular activity;
- 52 (ii) a work service program offered through the Department of Workforce Services; or
