The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 247**, SCHOOL SWIMMING AND LIFEGUARDING PROGRAMS, by Representative M. G. Ballard, with the following amendments:

 - 39 (b)ensure that the {rules} standards described in Subsection (1) include instruction in:
 - 40 <u>(i)safe behaviors in and around water;</u>
- 3. Page Line 50 through 52:







- 50 (B)CPR training described in Section 53G-10-408.
- 51 (3)Beginning in the 2027-2028 academic year, an LEA {-shall} may ensure that each student
- 52 receives instruction on water safety as described in this section.
