- 1. Page Line 238 through 238b:
  - 238 Subsection (6)(a) to obtain and operate the vehicle; or
  - 238a  $\hat{H} \rightarrow (ii)$   $\{ \underline{+} \}$  a tow truck operator or tow truck motor carrier that:
  - 238b (A)demonstrates that the tow truck operator or tow truck motor carrier has
- 2. Page Line 238e through 239:
  - 238e (B)provides a towing certificate issued by the Department of Transportation
  - 238f **pursuant to Section 72-9-602**; {**-and**}
  - 238g (C)pays all towing and storage fees  $\{-\}$  ; and  $\leftarrow \hat{H}$ 
    - (D) <u>obtains or presents an impound release for the vehicle, vessel, or outboard motor pursuant to Subsection (7)(a).</u>
  - 239  $\hat{H} \rightarrow [\underline{(ii)}$  is a tow truck operator or tow truck motor carrier that demonstrates that the  $\underline{tow}$ ]  $\leftarrow \hat{H}$
- 3. Page Line 408 through 410:
