The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 265**, HIGHER EDUCATION STRATEGIC REINVESTMENT, by Representative K. M. Peterson, with the following amendments:

- 1. Line 216 through 218a:

 - 217 {(2)} (a) "Institution of higher education" means an institution described in Section

 - 220 $\{\underline{(b)}\}$ (2) $\{\underline{(c)}\}$ (a) Under procedures and policies approved by the board and developed in
 - 221 consultation with each institution of higher education, each institution of higher
- 3. Line 250 through 255:
 - 250 (ii) The board may authorize a degree-granting institution to exceed the credit-hour
 - 251 limit described in Subsection (5)(a)(i) {by six additional credit hours to no more }
 - 252 {than 126 credit hours if the institution demonstrates to the board that a }
 - 253 {professional licensing or accrediting body requires additional coursework or credit}
 - 254 {hours in excess of the limit described in Subsection (5)(a)(i).} if the degree:
 - (A) is required for professional licensure; or

(B) has a nationally recognized accreditation standard that mandates a higher credit-hour minimum, including circumstances where additional coursework is necessary to protect public health, safety, and welfare.
