The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Committee reports a favorable recommendation on H.B. 285, WATER INFRASTRUCTURE MODIFICATIONS, by Representative C. Snider, with the following amendments:

1. Page Line 795 through 801:

795 contribution described in Subsection (2)(d).

796 (3) If a person seeking { water infrastructure fund money under this state or federal financing or grants establishes a need to

797 the satisfaction of a relevant agency, the relevant agency may provide the person:

(a) water infrastructure fund money to assist the recipient in complying with the 799 planning, reserve analysis, and capital asset management requirements of this part <u>or</u> Part 5, Capital Assets for Water ; or

800 (b) technical assistance with the planning, reserve analysis, or capital asset management

801 requirements of this part or Part 5, Capital Assets for Water.
