The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 343**, CANNABIS PRODUCTION AMENDMENTS, by Representative P. A. Cutler, with the following amendments:

1. Page Line 116 through 127:

 - 179 , before an individual submits a land use permit application for a cannabis production
 - 180 establishment, {+} at least one agricultural zone in which the operation of a cannabis
 - production establishment is a permitted use.
