The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 344**, SCHOOL FEES AMENDMENTS, by Representative M. A. Strong, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page Line 203 through 206:
 - 203 requirements for a high school diploma.
 - 204 (2)(a)Beginning for the 2026-2027 school year, except as provided in Subsection (2)(b), each LEA that awards credit toward
 - 205 graduation shall ensure that { a student has at the student's school, } each school has at least one option
 - 206 <u>for each graduation requirement that:</u>
- 2. Page Line 208 through 210:
 - 208 (ii)does not require the payment or waiver of any fee.
 - (b) Subsection (2)(a) does not apply to a charter school that only offers one of the following for a given graduation requirement:
 - (i) an Advanced Placement course;
 - (ii) an International Baccalaureate course; or
 - (iii) a concurrent enrollment course, as described in Section 53E-10-302.
 - 209 { (c) Nothing in this Subsection (2) requires an LEA or a school to
