The Government Operations Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 374**, SIGNATURE COLLECTION AMENDMENTS, by Representative M. L. Kohler, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page Line 10 through 13:
 - 10 political party to have the voter's signature removed from the petition;
 - 11 → requires an election official to post on the lieutenant governor's website the name { , voter
 - 12 identification number, and date of signature of each voter who signs a petition to
 - 13 nominate a candidate for elective office who is:

 - after the day on which the signature of an individual who signs a nomination

 - business days after the day on which the signature of an individual who signs a

 - 408 number, and date of signature of the individual on the lieutenant governor's website,
 - in a conspicuous location designated by the lieutenant governor, for at least 90 days.
- 5. Page Line 444 through 447:
 - business days after the day on which the signature of an individual who signs a
 - petition is verified under Section 20A-21-201, post the name { voter identification
 - <u>and date of signature of the individual on the lieutenant governor's website,</u>
 - in a conspicuous location designated by the lieutenant governor, for at least 90 days.
- 6. Page Line 464 through 466:
 - (b) An election officer who removes a voter's signature under Subsection (11) shall:
 - 465 (i)ensure that the voter's name {, voter identification number,} and date of signature are
 - not included in the posting described in Subsection (9)(d) or (10)(d); and
- 7. *Page Line 624 through 626:*
 - days after the day on which the signature of a voter who signs a signature packet is
 - 625 <u>verified under Subsection (5)(b), post the name</u> { , voter identification number, } and date of
 - 626 <u>signature of the voter on the lieutenant governor's website, in a conspicuous location</u>
- 8. Page Line 642 through 644:







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(b) A county clerk who removes a voter's signature under Subsection (7) shall:
