The Economic Development and Workforce Services Committee recommends H.B. 410, CHILD

CARE AMENDMENTS, by Representative T. J. Miller, be replaced and reports a favorable

recommendation on 1st Sub. H.B. 410, CHILD CARE AMENDMENTS with the following amendments:

- 1. Line 10 through 12:
  - 10 purposes of relicensing;
  - 11 →authorizes the use of housing and transit reinvestment zone funds to include <u>construction or</u> expansion of
  - 12 child care facilities within the zone; and
- 2. Line 57 through 59:
  - 57 employment duration in a district school, charter school, or accredited private
  - 58 school for purposes of {licensing} relicensing.
  - 59 (b) An educator who is enrolling in a course of study at an institution within the state
- 3. Line 114 through 116:
  - 114 the gap analysis described in Subsection 63N-3-604(2)[-]; or
  - 115 (viii) subject to Subsection (4)(b), costs for the construction or expansion of child care facilities
  - 116 within the boundary of the housing and transit reinvestment zone.
